

The special meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Lehman, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 6:00 p.m.

Present: Mayor Lehman; Councilpersons Cunliffe, Barrus, Linton, Johnson (arrived late), Moss, and Scoby; City Manager Bosanic, Assistant City Manager Feazel, and Clerk-Finance Director Rasmussen.

3. To receive comments regarding a proposed, amend Article III “Water Service” of the Code of the City of Greenville in order to clarify enforcement, inspections and remedies for noncompliance.

New Business

4. To consider the approval of amend Article III “Water Service” of the Code of the City of Greenville in order to clarify enforcement, inspections and remedies for noncompliance.

Councilperson Linton MOVED: To approve the proposed amendment to Article III “Water Service” of the Code of the City of Greenville Section 44-57 – Inspections and section 44-62 - Discontinuance of Service allowing the Water Department Employees access to building as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF GREENVILLE ORDAINS:

Section 1. Amendment. Section 44-57 of Chapter 44, Article III, Division 1 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Greenville, Michigan, is hereby amended in its entirety to read:

Sec. 44-57. – Inspections.

The city manager or their designee and city water department shall be permitted to enter upon all properties and buildings at reasonable times for the purpose of inspection, observation, measurement, sampling, performance of system upgrades and testing of all aspects of the water supply system, including but not limited to meters, piping and fixtures as deemed necessary by the City. Any person who applies for or

receives water from the system under this Article shall be deemed to have consented to inspections, including entrance upon that person's property at reasonable times to make such inspections and no person or persons shall interfere with such employees or refuse them access. Failure to allow such inspections may be cause to discontinue service pursuant to Section 44-62.

Section 2. Addition. Section 44-62 of Chapter 44, Article III, Division 1 of the Code of Ordinances, City of Greenville, Michigan, is hereby added as follows:

Sec. 44-62. – Discontinuance of Service.

If a water user’s meter cannot be read and inspected, including any aspect of the water supply system connected thereto, for a period of two (2) consecutive reading periods, and no satisfactory arrangement is made whereby such reading and inspection can be made within ten (10) days after the date of such scheduled second reading and inspection, the service may be discontinued and shall not be restored until the reading and inspection is made and payment for water consumed in such period plus a service fee as prescribed by resolution of the city council is paid or other satisfactory arrangements are made with the city treasurer. Further, in addition to any other remedy for any violation of this Article, the service may be discontinued after reasonable notice and opportunity to cure the same and shall not be restored until such violation is remedied in conformance with this Article as verified by the City.

Section 3. Publication and Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City within 10 days of its adoption and shall be effective 15 days after its adoption provided it has been published.

Councilperson Cunliffe seconded.

Adopted with a vote of (6) Ayes: Lehman, Scoby, Barrus, Cunliffe, Linton, and Moss; (0) Nays, and (1) Absent: Johnson.
