

The regular meeting of the Greenville City Council was called to order by Mayor Lehman, in the Council Chambers, in the Municipal Complex located at 415 S. Lafayette Street, Greenville, Michigan 48838 at 7:30 p.m.

3. Councilperson Moss MOVED: The consent Agenda be approved. Councilperson Johnson seconded. Unanimously adopted.

5. Council considered a contract with Prein&Newhof, Inc. of Grand Rapids for professional planning services in connection with the 2022 Airport Layout Plan Update at the Greenville Municipal Airport.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To approve the proposed contract with Prein&Newhof, Inc. of Grand Rapids, Michigan for professional services to conduct an update to the City's Airport Layout Plan not to exceed \$232,500 and authorize the City Manager to sign on the City's behalf as presented. Councilperson Cunliffe seconded. Unanimously adopted.

6. Council considered an application for a request for a crane and dumpster in the city parking lot next to 301 S. Lafayette from J & L Roofing.

Councilperson Moss MOVED: To approve the request from J & L Roofing representing owners of 301 S. Lafayette Street to occupy 6 public parking spaces in Lot 2 from November 14, 2022, to November 28, 2022, for the purpose of staging dumpsters and a crane as presented. Councilperson Johnson seconded. Unanimously adopted.

Councilperson Cunliffe MOVED: The meeting be adjourned. Councilperson Moss seconded. Unanimously adopted.
