DOWNTOWN PARKING LOT & WAYFINDING SIGNS

To: All Potential Bidders.

Notice: This addendum to the request for bids for design, procurement, and installation of Downtown Parking Lot & Wayfinding Signs. The amendments made herein shall become part of the bidding documents as originally issued.

No change in Bid Date: Tuesday, January 24, at 2:00 p.m.

Change to Information for Bidders:

The following questions have been asked in regard to this project and the answers are supplied after each question.

Q1. Is it okay to substitute a different size post with the bid.

A1. Yes, you can purpose the use of a different size post as long as it meets all state and local requirements for signs.

Q2. For signs numbers 17, 22, 23, 34, 46 & 47 are posts required to be supplied as well? Number 18 states that it is a panel only.

A2. Yes, the only reason 18 does not require a post is because the sign is installed on a street signpost.

Q3. Will the sign company need to pull any MDOT permits?

A3. No, the city will pull any required MDOT permits.

Q4. In the bid documents it states that there is a requirement for a warranty against fading included in the bid documents. Could you clarify what that means, a timeline, or more specifics?

A4. We just would like you to provide a warranty of some sort. Whatever you can provide. We have no requirement on length; however, it will be considered as a factor of the bid award.

Q5. For the building signs, can the sign be made slightly larger to hide any fading/screw holes/etc. that would be shown on the building from the existing sign.

A5. Yes, that would be acceptable.

Q6. The two (2) awnings on the building aren't on the bid documents, would you want a price to replace those?

A6. Yes, if your company can provide a price to replace the awning please do so as a separate line item on the bid page. That will not be a factor in the overall bid price for the signs.
