

History Preservation

When the white man first came in 1844 about 150 Native Americans lived in the northwest portion of what now is the City of Greenville. The tribes were mostly Ojibways, Ottawas and Potawatomies. Many trails criss crossed the area. Most important of these were what the white man designated as the Saginaw-Pentwater Trail and the UP River Trail. As the name indicates, the Saginaw-Pentwater Trail ran in a fairly straight line across the State between these two points. The UP River Trail ran from Lyons and Ionia to Turk lake and Lakeview, and on into the north.

About that time, John Green arrived to the area and built a sawmill and cabin for his family near the Flat River. The site is now the location of The Flat River Historical Museum. Greenville's original name was "John Green's Village". Many of the immigrants in those early days were from Denmark and brought with them their ethics for hard work and hard play, and a respect for the land that continues to this day. In recognition of those early pioneers, Greenville celebrates our heritage every 3rd weekend in August. Everyone is a "Dane-for-a-day" at the Danish Festival.

Our community works tirelessly to preserve our unique heritage and history. Our historic buildings and neighborhoods embody the lives of those who built, worked and lived in them. They tell stories about the past and provide a sense of place and continuity.

Claim to fame

The very first Meijer store was opened in Greenville by Hendrick Meijer in 1934. Meijer is now one of the largest shopping chains in the country. It's sort of a big deal.

Fighting Falcon Military Museum

If you like military history, this place is awesome. Greenville's Gibson Refrigerator Company made troop carrying gliders for the U.S. Army Air Forces in WWII. We have a complete replica of "The Fighting Falcon" and much more! (616) 225-1940 fightingfalcon.com

Flat River Historical Museum

Standing on the most historic site in Greenville, the Flat River Historical Museum is a local treasure of artifacts and exhibits depicting many facets of early life in Greenville. A welcoming entrance invites visitors to the MAIN FLOOR to view fossils from Ancient Seas, a Native American wigwarn and a fur trader store. They meet Greenville's founder, John Green, and marvel at the lumbermen who deftly rode their logs on the Flat River. They learn about our Danish heritage and discover what crops the area farmers produced and how products from local manufacturers and entrepreneurs made life easier! One can even relax a bit in the replica Silver Theater.

UPSTAIRS, visitors stroll the streetscape of 1880s Main Street Greenville and peek into the windows of businesses and residences from yesteryear to picture what life was like long ago. View the detail of the beautiful stained-glass window and read the story of how it came to be.

In the LOWER LEVEL, imagine the harnessmaker, carpenter and blacksmith at work in their shops and discover artifacts from long-ago daily home life, farming and refrigeration production. A mural of Bakdwin Lake and a rare Wright boat motor testify that life was not all work! OUTSIDE, one can stroll through a Victorian Garden on the path made from Greenville's original 1910 brick streets, relax beside the waterfall or sit in the corn crib gazebo. Outdoor artifacts extend the museum exhibit to view during changing seasons, even when the museum is not open.

Flat River District Library offers a genealogy room to help you trace your roots and discover your own personal history.

Outdoor Adventures

Greenville is surrounded with an abundance of water. No matter the season, our lakes, streams and rivers provide year-round fun. Greenville is the perfect destination for fishing, boating, canoeing, kayaking, snowmobiling, sledding and any water-sport imaginable.

Canoeing, kayaking, tubing, & fishing

The peaceful Flat River is a particularly attractive destination for beginning paddlers or those looking to introduce youngsters to the pleasures of floating a Michigan stream. Mild-mannered and shallow for most of its length, the Flat River threads its way through long stretches of public land that house a wide variety of wildlife. Pickleball.

Our Parks and Recreation department recently provided six pickle ball courts, available for use at their complex. Organized leagues are available.

Trails/Bicycling

The stunning Fred Meijer Flat River Trail meanders along the Flat River. At 9 miles, it encircles the city, and connects with the Fred Meijer Heartland Trail; taking you all the way to Alma! montcalm.org/trail.

Hard-Core Bicycling

Edwards Creek Mountain Bike Trail is 7.35 miles of winding intermediate and single track, including a good variety of terrain. The trailhead is at Alan G. Davis Park. The Shearer Road Mountain Bike Trail is a 4.5 mile course with rocks, logs, and other obstacles to add challenge to the beginner and intermediate trail loops. (616) 754-8887.

Parks

Each of Greenville's parks offers something different

Heritage Park

Home to the Ugly Duckling sculpture by renowned sculptor Marshall Fredericks; on the southwest corner of M-57 and M-91. Little known fact: Its twin sculpture is in our sister city, Skaelskor, Denmark.

Alan G. Davis Park

Near the Community Center, on the east side of Greenville, where we play a lot of softball. Also serves as a trailhead for the Fred Meijer Flat River and Edwards Creek Mountain Bike Trails.

Baldwin Lake

This beautiful, handicap accessible beach is located within city limits, and serves as a trailhead for the Fred Meijer Flat River Trail. Public boat launch is also available.

Danish Kingdom

In keeping with our Danish heritage, check out this Hans Christian Andersen fairy tale themed playscape. Near the community center, just east of town.

Jackson's Landing

Located on M-57 just east of Lafayette Street (M-91). This is a great spot to picnic and launch your kayak, with a modern floating-dock launch available. You can also pickup the Flat River Trail here and connect to other trail systems.

Pearl Street Park

On Pearl Street on the northeast side of Greenville. Take in a picnic, shoot some hoops or play on the playground.

Tower Riverside Park

On the banks of the Flat River this park is home to "The Little Mermaid" sculpture, our Rotary Club's "Rhythm on the River" concerts and a splash pad for family fun. Also serving as a trailhead for the Fred Meijer Flat River Trail.

Tower Park (Tower Mountain)

This park is the favorite winter destination for residents. Bundle-up and enjoy sledding, tubing or snowboarding on this fun hill. The park also provides an operating tow rope during winter months. Also serves as one of the main entrances for the Fred Meijer Flat River Trail.

Veteran's Park

Located on West Washington Street this park provides plenty of family fun opportunities. Residents can enjoy basketball, sand volleyball, picnics, playground fun and a new state-of-the-art skateboard park.

Lafayette Park

On Lafayette Street between Haan's Bakery and the Chamber of Commerce, Downtown events happen here; Greenville Car Show registration, Gus Macker Bracket info, Santa Park Party and Danish Festival activities. This park also serves as a gathering area within the GOLD district.

When in full bloom the hop yard is a work of art with 16 acres providing three varieties of hops. At harvest the vines will yield close to 1100 pounds of hops per acre, supplying Mackinaw, Michigan Copper, and Willamette varieties to the brewing world.

Greenville was home to the very first Meijer store, opened by Hendrick Meijer in 1934. Meijer is now one of the largest shopping chains in the country.

Today, national chain stores and restaurants co-mingle with local establishments, making Greenville an attractive shopping and dining destination.





Downtown

At the heart of our history is our downtown. Our DDA works hard at honoring our history and shaping the future for our downtown.

In 1844, John and Deborah Green arrived and purchased a plot of land and built a darn and sawmill. More settlers quickly arrived, including a millwright, blacksmith, carpenter, and doctor, who all settled in Greenville in 1845. The first merchant arrived in 1846, and a small business district began developing along Lafayette between Washington and Cass.

In an effort to preserve this history, a Downtown Historic District was established in 2008. This Historic District is listed on the National Register of Historic Places.

Today, Greenville's downtown contains 60 contributing buildings dating from the later nineteenth and early twentieth centuries; the oldest dates to 1869. Most of the structures are commercial blocks located along Lafayette, housing businesses on the first floor and office space or social meeting spaces on the upper floors. In 2021 the City of Greenville established GOLD (Greenville Outdoor Lafayette District), a designated district downtown that allows patrons to legally purchase and consume alcoholic beverages within the area.






