Trails & Parks

- Take a stroll (or ride) on our award-winning Fred Meijer Flat River Trail This beautiful trail surrounds the city winding along the Flat River connected with bridges and even an underground tunnel under M-57.
- The Fred Meijer Heartland Trail connects with the Meijer Flat River Trail at Jackson Landing (M-57) and travels northeasterly 25.8 miles from the parking area on M-91 in Greenville to Edmore.
- The Fred Meijer Flat River Valley Trail also intersects with the Fred Meijer Flat River Trail at Jackson Landing (M-57) and will take you south through Belding and Lowell.
- Canoe and Kayak Launch at Jackson's Landing (M-57). Paddlers of all abilities will be able to launch using the unique ADA accessible launch, paddle downstream to Belding and take-out at Belding using the identical launch.
- Veteran's Memorial Park in the heart of our community provides sand volleyball court, basketball courts, picnic area and a new stateof-the-art skateboard facility.
- Tower Riverside Park sits along the Flat River providing a scenic picnic area with a new splash pad for families to enjoy. Bring your lawn chair on the 3rd Thursday evening as Rotary presents Rhythm On The River (Jun-Aug).
- Enjoy the other 11 parks though out the community offering Disc Golf, playgrounds, tennis courts, pickleball courts and more.
