

SOME HELPFUL HINTS

FIRE HYDRANT SAFETY

At no time should anyone obstruct the visibility of a fire hydrant. Fire hydrants and the area around them need to remain free of any obstructions making the hydrant easily accessible to our Public Safety Officers.

During the winter weather if there is a fire hydrant located in the vicinity of your home, please keep it free of snow and debris making it easily accessible to our Public Safety Officers.

HOME OR BUILDING IDENTIFICATION

Please be sure to have the proper identification numbers on your home and or building.

This aids our Public Safety Officers and First Responders in locating your home in an emergency, when every second matters.

Numbers must be a minimum of 4 inches tall and displayed in a way that makes them easily visible from the street day or night.

OTHER INFORMATION

Please remember that at NO OTHER TIME, except during the bulk item week, can any other items be placed by the curb or roadside.

Any items placed at the curb or roadside will be considered littering and the City will immediately remove the item(s) resulting in removal and disposal fees billed to the homeowner/resident.

BULK ITEM & TRASH PICKUP **MAY 6TH - 10TH 2024**

SEE MAP FOR PICK-UP DAY IN YOUR AREA

American Waste of Michigan will be providing bulk item pick-up for the residents of Greenville.

- Bulk item pick-up will occur on your regularly scheduled trash collection day.
- This service is offered free of charge to Greenville Residents Only. **Please do not allow non-residents to drop off items for pick-up.** (Property owners violating provision will be prosecuted).
- **Bulk Item pick-up is not for commercial use. Those not included in bulk item pick-up are businesses, downtown apartment residents, and apartment complexes.**

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Place bulk items such as sofas, chairs, dressers, stoves, water heaters, carpet rolls, or old play sets at the curb on your regularly scheduled pick-up day by 6:00am, but no sooner than 24 hours in advance.
- Refrigerators, freezers, and air conditioners can be put out for pick-up only if they have been drained of Freon by a certified technician and must have a certification sticker indicating so.
- Please bag loose material in plastic garbage bags not to exceed 50 lbs.
- **Please do not place any bulk items at the curb any earlier than 24 hours before your scheduled trash day.**

UNACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- **Building materials and hazardous materials (tires, paint, chemicals, etc.) will not be picked up as they are prohibited to be placed in landfills by state law.**
- **NO ITEMS WEIGHING OVER 90 LBS. WILL BE PICKED UP.**
- **REMEMBER TO PUT LOOSE MATERIALS IN PLASTIC GARBAGE BAGS NOT TO EXCEED 50 LBS.**
- At no other time except Bulk Item collection week are residents allowed to put bulk items out to the street for pick-up. Any bulk items placed at the street at any time other than Bulk Item collection week will be removed at the homeowner's expense.
