The residents of the City of Greenville are allowed to bring their brush and or yard waste to the City’s Compost Site.

The attendant at the site will ask for proof of residency by way of your driver’s license. Contractors will need a photo copy or a picture of residence where materials were generated from, on a mobile device in order to use the facility.

Yard waste must be in bio-degradable paper lawn bags.

NO PLASTIC BAGS

Please be sure not to bring in any invasive type plant debris, such as Japanese Knotweed, or Oriental Bittersweet.

If you are not familiar with these plants please check the Internet for information on Invasive Plants.

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED

Stumps, lumber, concrete, rocks, building material of any kind.

SCREENED COMPOST

The City of Greenville has high quality screened compost for sale

\$14.50 per yard/we load.

You must purchase the screened compost at City Hall and then bring your receipt to the attendant and they will load you.

THE CITY OF GREENVILLE ANNOUNCES THE 2023 BI-WEEKLY BRUSH AND YARD WASTE COLLECTION DATES AND POLICIES

STARTING APRIL 3rd THRU OCTOBER 16th, 2023

POLICIES

Brush and Yard Waste must be out to the edge of the street by 7:00 am on the scheduled Mondays. City crews will collect the brush and/or yard waste as their schedule allows.

Brush and/or Yard Waste is not allowed in the street and must remain on the terrace or the edge of the street.

Brush shall not be longer than 8 feet in length and cannot be larger than 8 inches in diameter.

Brush needs to be stacked with all the butt ends facing the same direction.

No stumps allowed: stumps must be removed from any tree or shrubs.

Yard Waste must be in **bio-degradable paper lawn bags** and must not be in excess of 70 pounds.

Dirt and stones are not considered Yard Waste and therefore are not allowed.

Contractors: Brush and yard waste that is generated by contractors must be removed by that contractor.

Tree Removals: If a contractor removes a tree the contractor must remove the brush and yard waste.

Brush and/or Yard Waste that is placed out after the properly scheduled date will be tagged and the resident/homeowner will be responsible to remove the brush and/or Yard Waste until the following scheduled collection date.

SCHEDULED MONDAYS

STARTING IN APRIL AND ENDING IN OCTOBER

COLLECTION IS SCHEDULED FOR THE FIRST AND THIRD MONDAY OF EACH MONTH

CITY CREWS WILL PICK UP THE BRUSH AND/OR YARD WASTE AS THEIR SCHEDULE ALLOWS

PLEASE PUT YOUR BRUSH AND OR YARD WASTE OUT ON THESE SCHEDULED MONDAY'S ONLY

APRIL 3RD & 17TH

MAY 1ST & 15TH

JUNE 5TH & 19TH

JULY 3RD & 17TH

AUGUST 7TH & 21ST

SEPTEMBER 4TH & 18TH

OCTOBER 2ND & 16TH

Brush and/or yard waste that is placed out after the last scheduled Monday will be subject to a violation notice and will have to be removed from the terrace/street side. Failure to remove the brush and/or yard waste will result in a Need to Remove Notice, giving 3 days to remove. If it is not removed after the 3 days, City crews will remove the brush or yard waste and the homeowner/resident will be charged for that removal.
