Rank #	Description
1	Finance and complete Phase 3 of the WWTP renovation/expansion project.
2	Provide assistance when necessary and appropriate to the Drain Commissioner regarding drain issues in the City.
3	Fix downtown parking lots.
4	Pursue establishing a rental ordinance.
5	Develop low-impact road, stormwater, curb, and gutter design standards and update zoning ordinances.
6	Pursue grant funding and reconstruct and enhance Jackson's Landing Park.
7	Pursue grant funds and installation of wastewater pipes from the industrial park to the treatment plant.
8	Identify, develop, fund, and implement neighborhood trail connections to pedestrian trails.
9	Pursue grant funding and install additional splash pad features.
10	Develop a plan for the VFW lot and building.
11	Reconstruct Clay Street from Union to Montcalm Streets.
12	Extend the pedestrian connector trail from the Hathaway Assisted Living facility parking lot marked for the Dog Park/Trail.
13	Receive a report on the historical district, including projects denied, applied for, and completed.
14	Examine FAA rules and regulations for operating drones and see how they might apply to the usage within the City limits.
15	Resurface Community Center parking lots as part o the renovation and expansion project.
16	Organize and carry out a river clean-up.
17	Updated report on waterworks property and pursue redevelopment opportunities.
18	Bring back bike patrol if grant opportunities for personnel, equipment, and operational funds will allow.
19	Explore a utility ordinance that addresses unsightly and duplicate lines, poles, and other unsightly and/or unsafe issues in the City Rights of Way, especially along north M91.
20	Review and evaluate the need for new or extended sidewalks within the city limits and prioritize them.
21	Consider a charter amendment to allow City Council candidates to pay a fee instead of getting signatures.
22	Consider a Recreational Marijuana Ordinance.
23	Consider offering a town hall meeting to get community input.
24	Look at the availability of vacant property that could be used for additional parking lots downtown.

25	Explore collaboration and coordination between City Hall and the arts community, support and maintain public art installations, and pursue grant opportunities and private donations for public art project.
26	Pursue strategies to keep/lure college grads to Greenville: housing, transportation, walkability, recreation, entertainment, etc.
27	Bring a non-discrimination ordinance, specifically protecting sexual orientation and gender, to a vote of the City Council.
28	Install public Wi-Fi for downtown festivals.
29	Continue with the process to have an updated charter, review, and act upon the charter review committee recommendations.
30	Review the current front yard parking ordinance regarding cars for sale and make modifications to address issues or concerns.
31	Pursue extension of Charles Street to the truck route as development warrants.
32	Pursue installation/construction of the 3 dams along the Flat River where proposed.
33	Consider the extension of transit services to Stanton/Sidney if the opportunity arises and funds allow.
34	Pursue extension of N. Franklin from Charles Street to Gibson Drive.
35	Pursue development of the former TeleStar "park".
36	Explore the potential of an Inter-local Agreement with GRATA/"The Rapid" for transfer stations between transit systems.
37	Consider an ordinance requiring sidewalks with new construction.
