Rank #	Description
1	Finance and complete the WWTP renovation/expansion project.
2	Identify, develop, fund, and implement neighborhood trail connections to pedestrian trails.
3	Formulate a plan for the design of city-owned park spaces around the City and pursue the eventual development of them as reasonably possible. i.e.: Water Works Park property, Edgewood Village Park, Former VFW lot, Former TeleStar park, Hathaway Hills Park property, Hawthorn Park property, and the James F. Badge Park.
4	Consider long-range plans for expansion/development of Industrial Park.
5	Pursue grant funding and install additional splash pad features.
6	Develop, analyze, and implement way-finding signage for the Fred Meijer Flat River Trail throughout the City for improved direction to the trail and tunnel.
7	Evaluate, review and discuss ways to improve building department, receive a report.
8	Resurface Community Center parking lots as part of the renovation and expansion project.
9	Place more trash receptacles in the parks.
10	Continue to pursue opportunities to improve access to and from the Forest View Development.
11	Coordinate and advocate strategies to keep/lure college grads to Greenville: housing, transportation, walkability, recreation, entertainment, internships, etc.
12	Explore a utility ordinance that addresses unsightly and duplicate lines, poles, and other unsightly and/or unsafe issues in the City Rights of Way, especially along north M91.
13	Consider establishing a kayak launch to receive from the north.
14	Pursue establishing a rental housing ordinance.
15	Make improvements to disc golf course at Tower Park.
16	Develop low-impact road, stormwater, curb, and gutter design standards and update zoning ordinances.
17	Continue with the process to have an updated charter, review, and act upon the charter review committee recommendations.
18	Receive a report from the Historic District Commission on their guidelines and bylaws.
19	Consider a noise ordinance on loud exhausts.
20	Remove Locust trees and replace them with approved trees downtown.
21	Examine FAA rules and regulations for operating drones and see how they might apply to the usage within the City limits.
22	Review the current front yard parking ordinance regarding cars for sale and make modifications to address issues or concerns.
23	Evaluate the feasibility of installing a pedestrian crossing warnings system in key locations: e.g: Lafayette downtown, Washington at Baldwin or Luray, Washington at Walnut or Maple, M91 at FMFRT by GTD. Holland and Grand Rapids both utilize these, even on state trunk lines.

24	Look into the feasibility of Traffic Control Orders setting speeds and designating speed zones, especially along M57 in residential and school zones.
25	Consider a Recreational Marijuana Ordinance.
26	Look into timber cutting on city-owned property.
27	Set up a Mayor's Exchange with another community.
28	Organize and carry out a river clean-up.
29	Pursue installation/construction of the 3 dams along the Flat River where proposed.
30	Review and evaluate the need for new or extended sidewalks within the city limits and prioritize them.
31	Look into the feasibility of installing solar roofs for City parking lots.
32	Advocate for private EV charging stations.
33	Study the possibilities of creating "service drives" along West M57 corridor.
34	Acquire another Sister City in Denmark.
35	Consider the feasibility of creating a Land Bank.
