

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING GREENVILLE PLANNING COMMISSION

The Greenville Planning Commission will hold a public hearing for the purpose of receiving comments on amendments to the Greenville Zoning Ordinance. The proposed amendments would:

- Allow medical marihuana provisioning centers in a proposed North Lafayette Zoning District as a Special Land Use;
- Allow medical marihuana facilities and marihuana establishments except provisioning centers and retailers in the Industrial Zoning District as a Special Land Use and in the proposed Industrial Park Zoning District as permitted uses and provide regulations for these uses;
- Add a definition of school and other definitions pertaining to primary caregivers;
- Revise requirements for primary caregivers as a home occupation;
- Add regulations for the personal use of marihuana per the Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act;
- Create the North Lafayette and the Industrial Park Zoning Districts along with requirements for uses and development standards;
- Delete regulations prohibiting marihuana establishments and marihuana dispensaries, collectives and cooperatives; and
- Prohibit an extension of an expired site plan for a medical marihuana facility and a marihuana establishment.
