Post Meeting Brief

At the June 17th, 2024 Board of Commissioners' meeting, routine agenda items and essential operational needs were addressed by the Board. The Board Meetings are held in-person, in the Multipurpose Room/Commissioners Chambers, located on the 2nd Floor of the Judicial Center (119 Justice Drive, Winton). Highlights from the June 17th, 2024 Commissioners' Meeting:

- As part of the Consent Agenda, the Board approved the Meeting Minutes from June 3, 2024 and refunds were approved for two Hertford County Taxpayers.
- An important function of the Commissioners is to appoint citizen volunteers to the various committees and boards, which the Board has authority. The Commissioners unanimously reappointed the following individuals:

- Dr. Renee Tyler, Clerk to the Hertford County Board of Commissioners received her recertification as a North Carolina Certified County Clerk and she is the first in Hertford County to obtain this certification. Chairman Andre` M. Lassiter, Sr. and the Board of Commissioners expressed their gratitude for her efficient and effective performance as Board Clerk and she was commended for her exceptional accomplishment.
- The Commissioners adopted a balanced General Fund budget of \$30,278,407 while maintaining a tax rate of 0.84¢ per \$100 of valuation. Under the Board's guiding wisdom, this fiscally conservative budget appropriates finite resources across a broad spectrum of

services. The Commissioners' commitment and dedication to meeting the expectations of the community is evidenced in the details of the Fiscal Year 2025 – 2025 Budget document.

- Interim County Manager Patterson gave his report which included updates on the Dominion Energy Rebuild Project and the Ambulance Franchise in Hertford County.
