### Post Meeting Brief

At the June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2023 Board of Commissioners' meeting, routine agenda items, as well as essential operational needs were discussed by the Board. Highlights from the June 5<sup>th</sup>, 2023 Commissioners' Meeting:

- As a part of the Consent Agenda, the Board approved the Meeting Minutes from the May 15, 2023 meeting and Taxpayer Releases were also approved.
- Citizen/Customer service is a fundamental tenet of the Board's mission to deliver exceptional services to the community. One practice in support of this core tenet is investing in the County's staff. As a service organization, the Board knows that our success is intrinsically linked to hiring and maintaining a highly motivated and talented staff. One measure that the Board takes each month to demonstrate their appreciation for our staff is the introduction of new hires. This single action demonstrates the Commissioners' commitment to supporting their development and importance to the Hertford County team. During this meeting, the following new hires were all introduced for the month of June: Alton Cooper, Tyesha Edwards, Courtney Robinson, Barbara Watford, Shequita Futrell and Patricia Parker, all of whom will be working at the Hertford County Detention Center, and Stacey White will be working with Hertford County Emergency Services.
- As a measure to continue to prepare our county's youth for a career in public service, the Board unanimously approved a group of exceptional Summer Internship applicants. These approvals will provide a unique opportunity for the aspirants to gain firsthand experience in local government.
- The Board acknowledges and advocates for the citizen volunteers who serve on the various boards, commissions and committees appointed by the Commissioners. The Board unanimously approved the advertisement of current and upcoming board, commission, and committee vacancies.
- The Commissioners received a presentation from Ms. Joann Jones, PAWS of Hertford County detailing the not-for-profit's history and funding request.
- The County Manager presented the Fiscal Year 2023 – 2024 Budget Message, Budget Ordinance and supporting documents as a part of the annual budget public hearing.
