Post Meeting Brief

At the August 7th, 2023 Board of Commissioners' meeting, budget amendments along with essential operational needs were addressed by the Board. The Post Meeting Brief will be published on the County's website, Facebook page and it will be shared with our Sunshine List, media and County staff.

Highlights from the August 7th, 2023 Commissioners' Meeting:

- As a part of the Consent Agenda, the Board approved the July 17th, 2023 Meeting Minutes and June 2023 Taxpayer Releases.
- Citizen/Customer service is a fundamental tenet of the Board's mission to deliver exceptional services to the community. One practice in support of this core tenet is investing in the County's staff. As a service organization, the Board knows that our success is intrinsically linked to hiring and maintaining a highly motivated and talented staff. One measure that the Board takes each month in demonstrating their appreciation for our staff is the introduction of new hires. This single action demonstrates the Commissioners' commitment to supporting their development and importance to the Hertford County team. At this meeting, new hires for the month of July and August were introduced to the Board. These new hires are employed with different departments which include the Department of Social Services, the Sheriff's Office, Emergency Services, Rural Water, E-911, and the Tax Assessor's Office.
- The Commissioners approved the Order to collect all Real, Personal and Public Service Company Taxes for Fiscal Year 2023-2024. The Tax Collector was commended for another year of efficient tax collection.
- Commissioners approved Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Budget Amendment #27, and Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Budget Amendment #2 and RR-12.
- The Board unanimously approved a Proclamation recognizing August 6-12, 2023, as National Health Center Week, and the Proclamation was presented to Roanoke Chowan Community Health Center.
- NC Cooperative Extension introduced this year's delegate for the Youth Voice Conference, Sophia Howard, senior at Hertford County Early College. Youth Voice runs in conjunction with the North Carolina Association of County Commissioners State Meeting and will help Sophia increase her knowledge of local government.
- In the Board Clerk's Report, the public was notified of upcoming meetings and events in the community.
