Post Meeting Brief

At the August 21st, 2023 Board of Commissioners' meeting, a number of priorities and general business items were advanced by the Board. The Commissioners discussed important routine agenda items crucial to the ongoing operation of the County. The Post Meeting Brief will be published on the County's website, Facebook page and it will be shared with our Sunshine List, media and County staff.

Highlights from the August 21st, 2023 Commissioners' Meeting:

- ◆ As a part of the Consent Agenda, the Board approved the August 7th, 2023 Meeting Minutes, a Taxpayer Refunds were also approved.
- ◆ As an annual planning tool, the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Budget is one of the most important annual documents for local governments. All County services, programs, initiatives and general operations require funding. As such, the County adjusts revenue projections based on actual collections and expenditure forecasts based on fluctuating priorities. The Board approved Budget Amendment #3 for this Fiscal Year, and Budget Amendment #BA 28 was approved for Fiscal Year 2022-2023.
- ◆ The Commissioners received the Monthly Financial Report detailing the County's financial position as of June 2023.
- ◆ The EMS Summer Cadet program is designed to prepare high-school aged students for a career in Emergency Services. The Board recognized Madison Cullipher and Davion Ward for being the first participants to complete the program with Hertford County EMS. Madison and Davion both attend Hertford County Public Schools.
- ◆ As a part of their Community Recognitions Agenda Item, resolutions were unanimously approved to honor Mrs. Westelle Keys-Howington-Cherry and Ms. Orlanda Reid. Mrs. Keys-Howington-Cherry was honored for her outstanding contributions to the practice of medicine and her record of community service. Ms. Reid was honored for her outstanding contributions and the many years of distinguished service that she has provided to the citizens and other stakeholders in Hertford County.
