Post Meeting Brief

At the September 20th, 2022 Board of Commissioners' meeting, the Board discussed the annual budget document as well as several community support services. The Post Meeting Brief will be published on the County's website, Facebook page and it will be shared with our Sunshine List, media and County staff.

Highlights from the September 20th, 2022 Commissioners' Meeting:

- As a part of the Consent Agenda, the Board approved the September 6th, 2022 Meeting Minutes and North Carolina Vehicle Tax System Refunds for three taxpayers.
- As a demonstration of the Board's continued commitment to economic development, the Commissioners unanimously approved a letter to be sent to the Hertford Board of Education requesting the decommissioned Ahoskie Elementary School be deeded back to the County. The Commissioners' vision for the former school building is to establish an economic development small business incubator among other functions.
- The Board approved Amendments 3, 4 & RR-4 to the Hertford County Budget Ordinance for Fiscal Year 2022-2023.
- The Board received a community introduction from Hertford/Northampton County Opioid Crisis Coalition. The Commissioners fully support providing services to those experiencing an issue with chemical dependency and offering the County's endorsement for organizations committed to assisting these individuals in their time of need.
- Ms. Morgan Saunders who represented the Hertford County Cooperative Extension Office as the Youth Voice at the North Carolina Association of County Commissioners' Conference shared her experience and interest in future public service.
- The County Manager provided a brief update of upcoming projects and meetings. The Board Chamber's renovation is scheduled to begin October 10th with the renovations at the USDA office commencing immediately following the completion of the Chamber's work. The Manager stated that he will be meeting with Wolfstein Group to review the portfolio of lobbying services offered by the company.
