At the November 21st, 2022 Board of Commissioners' meeting, the Board discussed programs for the youth in our community as well as routine operational business. Highlights from the November 21st, 2022 Commissioners' Meeting:

- As a part of the Consent Agenda, the Board approved a taxpayer refund and a North Carolina Vehicle Tax refund for three individuals.
- The Board approved Amendments 7 & 8 to the Hertford County Budget Ordinance for Fiscal Year 2022-2023.
- The Commissioners approved a Resolution authorizing removal of certain public records kept by the Register of Deeds for the purpose of repair, restoration and rebinding.
- The Board approved the North Carolina Department of Aging and Adult Services American Rescue Plan Act grant in the amount of \$70,726 for the Department of Aging & Senior Services to be used for congregate and home delivered meals as well as supportive services.
- The Commissioners rejected a bid for County owned property located at 102 Holloman Avenue, Ahoskie.
- The Board approved a Lobbyist Service Agreement between Hertford County and Wolfstein, LLC.
- The Board approved the Sheriff's Bond Continuation Certificate.
- The Commissioners wished everyone a Happy Thanksgiving and safe travels.
