PRESENTATION OF THE OCTOBER 2022 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT REPORT

Ms. Kelly Bowers, Economic Development Director, presented the Economy Overview sharing as follows: even with the inflation, Hertford County is maintaining stability in the majority of our industry and commercial businesses and more of the impact on specific sectors will be known in December 2022 through 2023; Industry Video will be a marketing resource to highlight and increase the manufacturing base for Hertford County; as it relates to Agriculture Complex (Food Hub), Hertford County has industry opportunities due to land, location and agriculture community; and Hertford County will be applying for two parts of the Rural Transformation Grant (Rural implementation funds of \$49,999 for planning dollars for "Access Chowan" and community enhancements to spur economic growth with the Capital Investment amount to be determined.

PRESENTATION BY SENATOR BOB STEINBURG

Senator Bob Steinburg addressed Chairman Gatling and the Board stating he was glad to be in Hertford County and shared as follows: offered his services to the Board as a lobbyist to work to influence political decisions on behalf of Hertford County, propose new legislation, or the amendment of existing laws and regulations, effective February 1, 2023 he will be lobbying NC House and NC Senate; currently will be covering 11 counties, and suggested a 24-month contract for his services. Senator Steinburg concluded by stating that he felt Hertford County's potential is great and can make a difference in Northeastern North Carolina; and should Hertford County accept his contractual offer, Hertford County would have two lobbyist, Jeffery Stancil (24 months) and his services (23 months) at a cost of \$36,000.00 each per year, to thread the needle and make the pitch on the County's behalf.

Chairman Gatling thanked Senator Steinburg for coming to speak to the Board and for all he's done in Raleigh on behalf of Hertford County.

Com. Lassiter addressed Senator Steinburg asking him to keep the wish list for Economic Development as the big push in Raleigh in order that they see Hertford County's vision and remind everyone that US 13 and US 11 can save truckers about an hour on travel time.

Vice-Chair Horton commenting thanking Senator Steinburg for being in attendance and stated that the County need strong advocates for County funding needs.

County Manager Cotton stated he had no questions for Senator Steinburg and recommended to the Board that the Board engage Senator Steinburg's contract offer for the first term.

No public comment was given.

RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF ACCESS CHOWAN

WHEREAS, the Hertford County Board of Commissioners has elected to establish the Access Chowan Project to provide open access to public water and close-to-home outdoor recreation activities, which are designed to meet the expressed needs of the region and community; and,

WHEREAS, the Board supports and commits to provide a venue for outdoor recreation, which provide opportunities for quality of life enhancements for Hertford County citizens through health, socialization, and new business development; and,

WHEREAS, the Board sets as a goal to ensure the protection of natural assets along the Chowan River; and,

WHEREAS, the Board supports and affirms to expand the existing Hertford County-wide Recreation Plan to include Access Chowan; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board authorizes and approves the submission of a grant application to the North Carolina Department of Commerce Rural Transformation Grant Fund Program/Community Enhancement Grant in the amount of \$725,000 for real and personal property acquisition; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board authorizes and approves the submission of a grant application to the North Carolina Department of Commerce Rural Transformation Grant Fund/Rural Community Capacity Implementation Grant (RC2) in the amount of \$49,999 for Access Chowan Project development costs such as, but not limited to; master planning, environmental site research and review, surveying, soil tests, permitting, etc.

Rev. Odom commented regarding NC Tarheel Legislature representing citizens 65 and above, sharing senior citizens are important, thanked the Board for attention given to Quebec Road conditions in Harrellsville along with NCDOT.
