She discussed the planning of activities such as tours of historical areas, camp sites, cultural events and genealogy research. Ms. Ruth Akwright, cultivator has been in historic preservation for 40 years and states that we need energy to get people to visit Hertford County.

Chairman Freeman was excited about the visitor center.

Commissioner Farmer thought that Ahoskie had not done historical preservation well.

Commissioner Horton is looking forward to working with the Chamber of Commerce.

Commissioner Gatling stated that Hertford County had worked on this for two years strategically and had already met with the State of North Carolina and East Carolina. He would like to look at the bigger picture with all of the counties coming together.

PEANUT BELT RPO TRANSPORTATION COORDINATOR

Caleb E. Eller who is a Halifax employee is the new Transportation Coordinator for the Peanut Belt RPO. He explained to the Commissioners what the RPO does and how he assists in getting projects for state roads. He is also the coordinator for Bertie, Halifax and Northampton County. The Commissioners welcomed him. The County Manager stated that Hertford County has a lot of work and lobbying to do and we must watch the formulas so that we can be in the running.
