

Unlawful to operate vehicle while holding live animal in lap.

It shall be unlawful for any person to operate a vehicle on a public street, highway, or public vehicular area while holding a live animal in the person's lap. NC General Statute 20-137.4B.

A violation of this section shall be an infraction and shall be punishable by a fine of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) and the costs of court. This act becomes effective December 1, 2017, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
