Hertford County faces elevated risks from coastal hazards such as flooding, storm surge, and sea level rise due to its position along the Chowan, Meherrin, and Wiccacon Rivers. The County is working with SWCA Environmental Consultants to develop a Resilience Strategy that includes a risk and vulnerability assessment and priority resilience projects for the County to implement.
