4. Citizen Comments:

Wayne Newton made a motion to approve all consent items. Mary Combs Demby seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

- 10. Discussion and appropriate action regarding the approval of an Ordinance amending Title XV Entitled "Land Usage", Chapter 150 Entitled "Building Regulations", Article II Entitled "Building Code", Section 150.15 Entitled "Adoption of standard building codes." Darron Ray explained the amendments would be to require commercial building to have 6" numbers and letters on their buildings to display the street address and requires all new residential homes to have smoke and carbon monoxide detectors installed. Wayne Newton made a motion to approve an Ordinance amending Title XV Entitled "Land Usage", Chapter 150 Entitled "Building Regulations", Article II Entitled "Building Code", Section 150.15 Entitled "Adoption of standard building codes." Mary Combs Demby seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

11. Discussion and appropriate action regarding the approval of an Ordinance amending Title XV Entitled "Land Usage", Chapter 151 – Electrical Code.

Darron Ray explained the amendments to the Ordinance are to remove where the City issues a license and added the approved usage of aluminum wires for interior underground feeders. Andre Perkins made a motion to approve an Ordinance amending Title XV Entitled "Land Usage", Chapter 151 – Electrical Code. Wayne Newton seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

12. Discussion and appropriate action regarding the approval of an Ordinance amending Title XV Entitled "Land Usage", Chapter 150 Entitled "Building Regulations", Article IV Entitled "Mechanical Code", Sections 150.31 and 150.33.

Darron Ray explained the amendment was to adopt the 2018 Mechanical Code. Mary Combs Demby made a motion to approve of an Ordinance amending Title XV Entitled "Land Usage", Chapter 150 Entitled "Building Regulations", Article IV Entitled "Mechanical Code", Sections 150.31 and 150.33. Shawn Kadlecek seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

- 13. Discussion and appropriate action regarding the approval of an Ordinance Title XV Entitled "Land Usage", Chapter 150 Entitled "Building Regulations", Article V Entitled "Adoption of International Plumbing Code", Sections 150.45 and 150.46.

 Darron Ray explained the amendments are to adopt the 2018 Plumbing Code and to require a 12" depth for sewer lines. Wayne Newton made a motion to approve an Ordinance Title XV Entitled "Land Usage", Chapter 150 Entitled "Building Regulations", Article V Entitled "Adoption of International Plumbing Code", Sections 150.45 and 150.46. Mary Combs Demby seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.
- 14. Discussion and appropriate action regarding the approval of an Ordinance amending Title XV Entitled "Land Usage", Chapter 150 Entitled "Building Regulations", Article VIII Entitled "Adoption of International Property Maintenance Code", Sections 150.91 and 150.92.

Darron Ray explained the amendments are to adopt the 2018 International Property Maintenance Code and to remove sections that are no longer in the International Property Maintenance Code. Andre Perkins made a motion to approve of an Ordinance amending Title XV Entitled "Land Usage", Chapter 150 Entitled "Building Regulations", Article VIII Entitled "Adoption of International Property Maintenance Code", Sections 150.91 and 150.92. Wayne Newton seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

15. Discussion regarding parking issues on Mecom Way from Highway 6 to Jay Road. Chief Wilmon Smith, Ofc. Alex Hickerson, and Ofc. Mary Wooldridge expressed concern that emergency vehicles are not able to pass down Mecom Way due to residents parking on the roadway. They suggested crating an ordinance to not allow parking on the street on this road.

No action taken.

16. Discussion and appropriate action awarding the Emergency Debris Removal Contract.

Ofc. Mary Wooldridge recommended awarding the Emergency Debris Removal Contract to Crowder Gulf. Wayne Newton made the motion to award Crowder Gulf the Emergency Debris Removal Contract. Mary Combs Demby seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.

17. Discussion and appropriate action approving a payment of \$550,000 from the TIRZ One (Harborwalk) account to Harborwalk, LP pursuant to the Indenture of Trust Amendment to Development and Financing Agreement dated September 1, 2006, by and between the City of Hitchcock, Reinvestment Zone Number One, City of Hitchcock, Texas, Wells Fargo Bank, NA and Harborwalk, LP. regarding TIRZ Payment.

Wayne Newton made a motion to approve a payment of \$550,000 from the TIRZ One (Harborwalk) account to Harborwalk, LP pursuant to the Indenture of Trust Amendment to Development and Financing Agreement dated September 1, 2006, by and between the City of Hitchcock, Reinvestment Zone Number One, City of Hitchcock, Texas, Wells Fargo Bank, NA and Harborwalk, LP. regarding TIRZ Payment. Andre Perkins seconded the motion. Motion passed 5-0.
