Sec. 36-675g. - Parking restrictions.

(a) No person shall stop, stand, or park a vehicle except when necessary to avoid conflict with traffic or in compliance with law or the direction of a public safety officer, in violation of any legally established parking restriction or prohibition; provided that signs stating such restrictions or prohibitions are duly posted in accordance with this article, except that a driver of a passenger vehicle may stop temporarily in such restricted or prohibited parking zone for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading of passengers when such stopping does not interfere with traffic.

(b) A person shall not park a vehicle upon a street between the hours of 3:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m., except:

- (1) When necessary to avoid conflict with other traffic,
- (2) In compliance with the law or the directions of a public safety officer, or
- (3) The resident met the criteria outlined in the section below.

(c) A person who violates this section is responsible for a civil infraction.

Criteria used to determine eligibility for RESIDENT 3:00 a.m. - 5:00 a.m. PARKING PERMIT:

- (1) A one-car or two-car garage counts as one parking space;
 - (2) The number of registered vehicles *must* exceed the parking capacity of your property;
 - (3) Parking capacity will be determined by Public Safety measuring the length and width of the driveway between the garage door and the property line. A parking space is defined as an area that is 8 ft. in width by 20 ft. in length. For corner lots, driveways less than 18 ft. in length will not count as a parking space.
 - (4) All vehicles must be registered to the address of the resident requesting the permit;
 - (5) Vehicle registrations must be presented at the time of application;
 - (6) The vehicle shall be parked in accordance with the regulations of section 36-674 with the permit displayed in the lower left corner of the rear window.
- The fee for the permit shall be established by resolution of the city commission.

PLEASE NOTE: All 3-5 permits expire December 31st of the year issued and you must re-apply every year.
