



Dump Truck Rental

For use by RESIDENTS ONLY. A city dump truck will be dropped off overnight or over most weekends. In general, city trucks are available for house or garage cleaning. DUMP TRUCKS MAY NOT BE USED FOR CONSTRUCTION MATERIAL WITHOUT PRIOR PERMISSION. Construction material includes, but is not limited to, decking, bricks, plaster, tile, lumber, shingles. If you are unsure if your material is classified as construction material be sure to ask before you rent the truck. There is a charge for the disposal of any construction material.

Cost: Please bring two (2) checks made out to the "City of Huntington Woods" for the following:

Truck rental fee, \$75.	Includes the disposal of certain household refuse.
Solid waste disposal fee*, \$175.	Non-household refuse will be charged at \$54/ton based on weight, not to exceed \$125.

* covers penalty if truck is overloaded and must be handled at the DPW yard.

Availability:

The 7 cubic yard capacity dump truck is available *to residents only* over night or on weekends from May through September, subject to the prior needs of the DPW.

The truck will be delivered to your home by 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, excluding holidays, and will be picked up by 8:00 a.m. the next work day. The truck must be placed on the homeowner's property and cannot be put in the street or across the city sidewalk. Someone must be present when the truck is dropped off.

THE TRUCK WILL BE LOCKED AND CANNOT BE MOVED ONCE PARKED.

Debris should be placed in the truck so that it does not extend beyond the wood side boards or hinder the back tailgate from being closed and secured. If the truck must be emptied at DPW to safely transport the debris to SOCRRA, a \$50 penalty will be assessed and will be deducted from the penalty/solid waste disposal fee. If material must be dumped in the DPW yard and is placed in the city roll-off, a minimum disposal fee of \$54 will be assessed along with the \$50 penalty.

Special Instructions:

Concrete disposal: If the truck is rented for concrete disposal, nothing else can be mixed into the load. Concrete *only* can be dumped by DPW at a crusher site.

Items which cannot be placed in truck: Tires, yard waste including logs, dirt, electronics or any toxic waste.

Damage: Any damage to the truck must be reported to DPW on the next working day.
