

**NOTICE OF REGISTRATION FOR THE ELECTION TO BE HELD ON
TUESDAY, AUGUST 8, 2023
CITY OF HUNTINGTON WOODS**

To the Qualified Electors of the City of Huntington Woods, County of Oakland:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that any qualified elector of the City of Huntington Woods who is not already registered, may register to vote at the City of Huntington Woods Clerk's Office; the office of the County Clerk; a Secretary of State branch office, or other designated state agency. Registration forms can be obtained at mi.gov/vote or www.hwmi.org and mailed to the City Clerk. Voters who are already registered may update their registration at www.expressSOS.com.

The last day to register in by mail, online or in-person with the local clerk is **Monday, July 24, 2023**

After this date, starting July 25, 2023, anyone who qualifies as an elector may register to vote in person with proof of residency (MCL168.492) at the City of Huntington Woods Clerk's office, located at 26815 Scotia Rd., Huntington Woods, MI 48070 at the following times:

- Monday – Friday, 8:30am – 5:00pm (closed for lunch from 1:00-2:00pm except for the week prior to election)
- Saturday, August 5, 2023 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- **Election Day, Tuesday August 8, 2023 from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.**
- **PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that the City of Huntington Woods will be holding a Special Election for the purpose of voting on the following bond proposal.

Shall Berkley School District, Oakland County, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Eight-Eight Million Dollars (\$88,000.00) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefore in one or more series, for the purpose of:

Erecting, furnishing and equipping a new indoor practice/robotics team building; erecting, furnishing and equipping additions to school buildings; remodeling, furnishing and equipping and re-equipping school buildings; acquiring, installing, equipping and re-equipping school buildings for instructional technology; and preparing, developing, improving and equipping playgrounds, athletic fields and facilities and sites?
