BE PREPARED FOR SUB-ZERO WIND CHILLS AND BLOWING SNOW WHICH WILL REDUCE VISIBILITY AND MAKE ROADS SLICK AND DANGEROUS. IF YOU HAVE TO DRIVE, PLEASE GIVE YOURSELF EXTRA TIME TO SAFELY GET TO YOUR DESTINATION.

ALSO, **AN IMPORTANT REMINDER** TO ANY RESIDENTS WHO ARE SIGNED UP FOR THE CITY'S **SENIOR SNOW REMOVAL SERVICE**.

THE SERVICE IS ACTIVATED **ONLY AFTER 4-INCHES** OR MORE OF SNOW HAS FALLEN – AND – **ONLY AFTER ALL CITY STREETS HAVE BEEN PLOWED**. PLEASE BE PATIENT. EACH OF THE CONTRACTORS HAVE 16-HOURS TO PLOW RESIDENTS PRIMARY DRIVEWAYS ONCE.

IF YOU HAVEN'T ALREADY, MAKE SURE YOU HAVE AN EMERGENCY KIT IN YOUR CAR IN CASE YOU RUN OUT OF GAS, GET A FLAT TIRE OR GET STRANDED IN A STORM. YOU CAN FIND MORE INFORMATION IN MY WEEKLY UPDATE ON THE HOMEPAGE OF THE CITY'S WEBSITE.
