A POWERFUL WINTER STORM IS HEADED OUR WAY AND I WANT MAKE SURE EVERYONE STAYS SAFE.

ON WEDNESDAY MORNING THE STORM WILL START OUT AS RAIN -- THEN AS TEMPERATURES DROP THROUGHOUT THE DAY -- IT WILL TURN TO SLEET AND SNOW. THAT'S A CHALLENGING COMBINATION.

THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT CREWS ARE **SCHEDULED TO WORK AROUND-THE-CLOCK FROM WEDNESDAY** THROUGH SATURDAY.

PLEASE BE PATIENT AND STAY HOME IF YOU CAN. THIS STORM IS EXPECTED TO DUMP L BE DUMPING HEAVY, WET SNOW THAT WILL MAKE DRIVING TRECHEROUS. FORECASTERS ARE PREDICTING 8-TO-12 INCHES BY FRIDAY NIGHT.

ALSO, TO THE MORE THAN 700 RESIDENTS WHO ARE SIGNED UP FOR SENIOR SNOW REMOVAL.... YOU DO NOT NEED TO CALL THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT.

ONCE 4-INCHES OF SNOW HAVE FALLEN AND THE MAIN STREETS ARE CLEAR, CONTRACTORS WILL BE CALLED TO OPEN DRIVEWAYS.

WE HAVE FIVE CONTRACTORS. THEIR CREWS EACH HAVE 16-HOURS TO COMPLETE THEIR ROUTES TO PLOW MORE THAN 700 DRIVEWAYS.
