IN THE NEXT FEW WEEKS THE CITY WILL BE CALLING ALL RESIDENTS TO RECONFIRM CONTACT INFORMATION. MANY PEOPLE NO LONGER HAVE LANDLINES, AND USE THEIR CELL PHONES INSTEAD. THE CITY EMPLOYEES WILL IDENTIFY THEMSELVES AND ONLY ASK FOR CONTACT INFORMATION. THE CALL SHOULD TAKE LESS THAN 5-MINUTES.

AFTER THREE LONG MONTHS, OHIO'S OVERNIGHT CURFEW HAS BEEN LIFTED....

AND, CEI HAS AGREED TO TAKE DOWN TEN ELECTRICAL TRANSMISSION TOWERS BETWEEN THE SUB-STATION NEAR I-77, EAST TO THE PROPERTY BEHIND INDEPENDENCE PRIMARY SCHOOL.
