HELLO, IT IS FEBRUARY 19TH. PLEASE STAND BY FOR A MESSAGE FROM THE MAYOR.
THIS MESSAGE WILL REPEAT ONCE.

GOOD FRIDAY EVENING. THIS IS YOUR MAYOR GREG KURTZ.

I AM PLEASED TO REPORT THAT THE SUPPLY OF COVID-19 VACCINES TO PHARMACIES HAS DOUBLED NATIONWIDE TO TWO MILLION DOSES A WEEK.

THE INCREASE IN DOSES AND THE ADDITION OF AUTHORIZED VACCINATION SITES MEANS PEOPLE WILL BE ABLE TO GET VACCINATED SOONER.

IF YOU HAVE REGISTERED WITH MULTIPLE FACILITIES TO RECEIVE A VACCINE, PLEASE TRY TO TAKE THE FIRST AVAILABLE APPOINTMENT. REMEMBER, EVERYONE WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE SCHEDULED TO GET THEIR SECOND "BOOSTER" VACCINE AT THE SAME LOCATION. THIS IS THE ONLY WAY TO MANAGE THE DISTRIBUTION OF VACCINES.

A REMINDER: ANY RESIDENT, WHO NEEDS ASSISTANCE REGISTERING FOR A COVID-19 VACCINE, SHOULD CALL COMMUNITY SERVICES.

REGARDLESS IF YOU RECEIVED THE VACCINE OR NOT, PLEASE CONTINUE TO WEAR A MASK AND SOCIALLY DISTANCE.

LET'S NOT DECLARE VICTORY TOO SOON. THE MORE CONTAGIOUS AND DANGEROUS STRAIN OF COVID-19 HAS BEEN IDENTIFIED IN OHIO.
