THE FIRST MEETING OF THE 2022 CHARTER REVIEW COMMISSION WAS HELD AT CITY HALL THIS WEEK. OUR CHARTER IS THE CITY'S VERSION OF THE U.S. CONSTITUTION.

UNDER THE CITY CHARTER, **ELEVEN RESIDENTS** ARE APPOINTED TO CONDUCT A **COMPREHENSIVE REVIEW** OF THE CHARTER **EVERY FOUR YEARS**. DURING THE PUBLIC MEETINGS, THE COMMISSION WILL DECIDE -- AS A GROUP --WHAT UPDATES, ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO THE CHARTER SHOULD BE SUBMITTED TO COUNCIL FOR CONSIDERATION.

COUNCIL WILL THEN REVIEW THE COMMISSION'S RECOMMENDATIONS -- MAKE AMENDMENTS IF NECESSARY -- AND DETERMINE WHICH ISSUES SHOULD BE PLACED ON THE NOVEMBER BALLOT FOR A VOTE BY RESIDENTS.

I WANT TO THANK THE MEMBERS OF THE COMMISSION WHO HAVE AGREED TO SERVE OUR CITY IN THIS VITAL ROLE.
