

Mayor Kurtz's SwiftReach for January 13 2023 (Rev)

HELLO, IT IS **JANUARY 13TH**, PLEASE STAND BY FOR A MESSAGE FROM THE MAYOR.

GOOD FRIDAY EVENING! THIS IS YOUR MAYOR GREG KURTZ.

THE CITY AND ODOT HAVE BEGUN AN **IMPROVEMENT PROJECT** TO WIDEN THE I-77 NORTHBOUND EXIT RAMP AT ROCKSIDE ROAD NEAR BOB EVANS.

IF YOU DRIVE THROUGH THE AREA, YOU WILL SEE WOODEN UTILITY POLES ARE BEING INSTALLED. THESE WILL BE USED TO SUPPORT **TEMPORARY TRAFFIC SIGNALS** THAT ARE NEEDED DURING CONSTRUCTION.

THE WOODEN POLES AND TEMPORARY TRAFFIC SIGNALS WILL BE REMOVED ONCE THE PROJECT IS COMPLETED. YOU CAN FIND MORE INFORMATION IN MY WEEKLY UPDATE.

IF MONDAY IS YOUR REGULAR RUBBISH DAY, NEXT WEEK THE SERVICE DEPARTMENT WILL PICK UP YOUR TRASH AND RECYCLING ON TUESDAY, JANUARY 17TH. CREWS WILL BE MAKING DOUBLE PICK-UPS THAT DAY, WHICH MEANS SOME TRASH COLLECTION **MAY OCCUR** AFTER 4:30 PM.

NEXT SATURDAY, JANUARY 21ST CITY COUNCIL AND I WILL HOLD OUR ANNUAL STRATEGIC PLANNING MEETING STARTING AT 9 AM. **THE MEETING IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC VIA ZOOM. PLEASE REGISTER ON THE WEBSITE.**
