

## Tuesday, November 29, 2016

The Committee Members present were Rudy Carter, Ron Burke, Earl Capps, and Leonard Sims. Absent were Al Palmer and Jack Patterson. Also present was Senator Greg Gregory, Representative-elect Brandon Newton, SCDOT District 4 Administrator John McCarter, County Public Services Director Jeff Catoe, County Administrator Steve Willis (acting Clerk to Committee) and a number of spectators. A quorum of the Lancaster County Transportation Committee was present for the meeting.

The following press was notified of the meeting by e-mail or by fax in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act: Lancaster News, Kershaw News Era, The Rock Hill Herald, Fort Mill Times, Cable News 2, Channel 9 and the local Government Channel. The agenda was also posted in the lobby of the County Administration Building the required length of time and on the county website.

## Call to Order

Chairman Rudy Carter called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. He lead the group in the Pledge of Allegiance and provided the invocation.

## Approval of the Agenda

- 2. Jeff Catoe of Lancaster County spoke regarding roads that are projects under the Capital Project Sales Tax, Catawba Council of Governments, or the County Transportation Committee. Please see the attached handout for the list of roads.
- 3. Jeff Catoe of Lancaster County spoke regarding the roads that are projects under the Legislative Delegation Special Funding program. Please see the attached handout for the list of roads.
- 4. Jeff Catoe of Lancaster County spoke regarding several county dirt roads, including Balkcum Road, Leadoff Road, Logging Road, and Witherspoon Trail. No motions were made and the Transportation Committee took these roads under advisement for future consideration.
- 5. Jeff Catoe of Lancaster County spoke on the condition of guardrails along Sardis Road and Skipper Avenue. Earl Capps moved to have cost estimates and proposals prepared for consideration at the next meeting due to safety considerations, seconded by Leonard Sims. Passed 4-0.

Chairman Carter allowed Steve Willis of Lancaster County to inquire if the Transportation Committee would like additional information on several projects for future consideration. They were:

- Phased paving with triple treatment of all gravel roads north of SC 5. This would be a safety initiative to remove motor graders and dump trucks from heavily travelled US 521 North.
- Phased resurfacing of county roads that are in effect driveways that were adopted into the system decades ago. This would be conditioned upon the owner consenting to removal of the road from the county road system and it reverting to private ownership.
- Potential use of microsurfacing to extend the life of roads.

The Committee requested these ideas be researched and also asked that staff include requesting the County Fire Commission to identify roads and/ or intersections that are critical to them. This would be reported back for such consideration as the Committee desires.



Sardis Road guard rail/safety improvements

## Issue for Consideration:

Update on status of proposed Witherspoon Trail relocation (New school project)

## Points to Consider:

If approved, a portion of Witherspoon Trail will be located and updated to paved status. There is a possibility to include the remainder of Witherspoon Trail for upgrades

## **Funding and Liability Factors:**

Relocation would be funded by School District. Remainder would be administered/funded by CTC. Project is in concept only currently, so no cost estimate available

## Recommendation:

Once plans for relocation have final approval, prepare a cost estimate for CTC to discuss and consider improving remainder of Witherspoon Trail to North Carolina state line.

## Issue for Consideration:

Candidates for SCDOT 25% resurfacing

## Points to Consider:

SCDOT will reclaim with in house forces 3 roads late summer/early fall (Collins Road, Charles Pettus Road, and Plyler Mill Road). They have requested another partnership with CTC on the resurfacing portion. This program has been very effective for all entities.

## Funding and Liability Factors:

Funding for resurfacing would be from C fund balance/reserves and exceed the 25% minimum set aside for this FY

## **CTC Options:**

- 1) Approve and move forward with bid process late summer/early fall with a 11/01/17 deadline
- 2) Disapprove

## Recommendation:

Approve and have staff move forward with project for 2017 completion. The timing and coordination are crucial to the project, and approval would eliminate a call from the Chairman to have a special meeting to approve in August/September. Staff could move forward with planning/coordinating/scheduling with DOT staff.
