**New Business –**

Spoke on finalizing the lifeguards that were being hired and the summer camp workers.

Chris also addressed the budget briefly; he is requesting to reduce the registration fee for the 23/24 seasons. Also, that somehow in the budget a request for \$300,000 for new floors was asked for. Do not know when or who asks that but it's there.

Chris Amodeo asks about getting donations. Chris Clouden said that the agency is not set up for that right now.

The pool will open May 20<sup>th</sup> open 6 days a week closed on Sundays. We had 91 sign up for the Swim Team. Will have 3 home meets.

Chris Amodeo asks if there was going to be any summer sports, Jason spoke and said not this year, but staff will be working on sports programs.

Jason wanted the board to know that LCPR will have its first ever Summer Palooza. June 3<sup>rd</sup> rain out date will be June 17<sup>th</sup>. All sports and community will be invited to it. Games, music, foam, water slides, jumping houses, vendors. Chris and Jason are working with Duke Energy to be a Co-Sponsor of the event.

Jason is working on getting surveys out on all Spring parents on the feedback for the season. Will be sending those out via email to all.

Maintenance is working hard to get everything in working order and fields ready for resting. Chris and Jason will be doing a walk through on Harrisburg complex and Heath Springs Complex sometime next week.
