Lancaster County

The Democratic and Republican parties will hold primaries on Tuesday, June 11, 2024. Any necessary runoffs will be held on Tuesday, June 25, 2024. Any person wishing to vote in the primaries and runoffs must register no later than Sunday, May 12, 2024. Voter registration forms received by mail will be accepted if postmarked by Monday, May 13, 2024.

The early voting period for these primaries begins on Tuesday, May 28 and ends on Friday, June 7. The following early voting centers will be open during the early voting period from 8:30 a.m. until 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday (closed Saturdays and Sundays).

Voters will be asked to provide one of the following Photo IDs at their polling place:

- S.C. Driver's License
- ID Card issued by S.C. Department of Motor Vehicles
- S.C. Voter Registration Card with Photo
- Federal Military ID
- U.S. Passport

Voters should remember to bring one of these IDs with them to the polling place. Voters without Photo ID can get one free of charge from their county voter registration office or the Department of Motor Vehicles.
