## Work Release Rules and Regulations

- I will comply with all the rules and regulations of the inmate handbook.
- I will comply with all local, state and federal laws.
- Any travel other than to and from work must be communicated with the work release coordinator. (Meetings, meals, laundry mat, etc).
- I must give proper notification of appointments that have been directed by the court. Any other appointments will need to be approved by Work Release Coordinator.
- I understand that I can be regressed for not being at my assigned work place when an on-sight job check is done or when a deputy reports I was seen some place other than the assigned work place.
- I agree to return to the La Plata County Jail at the time specified on the work schedule. If for any reason my work day is shorter than the schedule states, I must return to jail.
- I understand I may be searched each time I enter or leave the La Plata County Jail. I may be subject to a strip search, body scanner, or pat down.
- I agree to submit to a urinalysis or tests of my breath and/or blood when request by the jail staff. Any cost incurred from said test is my responsibility. I understand that I will be regressed for showing positive on said tests.
- I understand that I am responsible for all expenses (medical, dental, commissary, UA test, etc) while in the La Plata County Jail.
- I understand that no tobacco products of any kind are allowed in the La Plata County Jail.
- I understand that if I am taking medication prescribed for me by my physician, it must be stated at time of booking and arrangements can be made with medical staff.
- I understand that I am to have no medication on my person or in the work release cell block.
- I understand that any violation of the work release rules or violation of the law will result in the forfeiture of any and all funds paid to the work release program.
- If my work schedule changes, I must inform the Work Release Coordinator within 24 hours prior to the change. Weekend changes will need at least a 48-hour notice.
- I understand that if I am returning late to jail, I must notify the work release coordinator or the jail watch commander (970-382-7053) if there is an emergency that would cause me to be late.
- I understand that my cell and personal effects will be subject to periodic searches.
- I understand that I may order paperback books as long as they are sent directly to the La Plata County Jail. Books must not be material advocating illegal drug use, violence, or contain sexually explicit material.

- I understand that no illegal drugs, alcohol, or other contraband may be brought into the facility. Such actions will result in separate charges being filed.
- I understand that if I knowingly attempt to escape, I am guilty of an additional crime and upon conviction thereof, I can be punished by imprisonment in the county jail or department of corrections. This sentence shall run consecutively with any sentence I am now serving.
- I understand that I may sign up for the meals served at the jail. Meals are served at approximately the following times:
  - Breakfast – 6:20am
  - Lunch – 11:20am
  - Dinner – 4:20pm
- Dinner trays will be refrigerated if I am not back from work by dinner time.
- I understand that if my work schedule has me out of jail past 6:30pm, I may purchase food before returning to the jail. Food must be eaten before checking into jail.
- I understand that I may order commissary while in the work release program.
- I understand that on Sunday and Thursday nights, I may receive hygiene items through supply cart (shampoo, soap, toothpaste, deodorant).
- I understand that the amount of money allowed on my person daily is up to \$20 with no more than \$2 in change.
- I understand that no outside purchase or vending items are allowed in the jail.
- I understand any items found in my cell or in my possession other than jail issued items and approved items can cause me to be regressed.
