Entry fees are not required in the 4-H/FFA classes. Late entries will **not** be accepted. Cavies must provide their own secure cage.

Please note that all exhibitors are responsible for their own food (none will be provided). Please bring your own food dish and water container. Every exhibitor is responsible for the care, feeding and cleaning of their own animals. (the barn workers will not be feeding, watering, or cleaning pens.) If you are not able to feed one morning, talk to another club member to help you out.
