

Road Maintenance and Improvement Fees

House Bill 11-1113 requires a county or municipal government to publish information detailing any land development charge, including the annual interest rate on each account and the total amount disbursed during the most recent fiscal year, at least once annually on the local government's official web site.

**La Plata County collects land development fees associated with oil and gas Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), Road Improvement Agreement (RIA), or Road Mitigation Fees (RMF).
