**CITY OF LOGAN
ORDINANCE NO. 05-56**

ADOPTING THE 2003 EDITION OF THE INTERNATIONAL FIRE CODE

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOGAN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 8.04.010 of the Logan Municipal Code, 1989, is hereby amended to read follows:

8.04.010 International Fire Code Adopted.

A. There is adopted by the city for the purpose of prescribing regulations governing conditions hazardous to life and property from fire, hazardous materials or explosion, that certain code known as the international fire code.

1. The following appendices from the international fire code, latest edition, are adopted by the city as guidelines only:

- a. Appendix A - board of appeals
- b. Appendix B - fire flow requirements
- c. Appendix C - fire hydrants locations and distributions
- d. Appendix D - fire department access roads
- e. Appendix E - hazardous categories
- f. Appendix F - hazard ranking
- g. Appendix G - cryogenic fluids-weights and volume equivalents.

B. The foregoing fire code is published by the International Code Council, being particularly the ~~2000~~ 2003 edition thereof and the whole thereof, except such portions which are specifically excepted by this section, three (3) copies of which have been and are now filed in the office of the clerk of the city and the same are adopted and incorporated as fully as if set out at length herein, and from the effective date hereof, the provisions thereof shall be controlling within the limits of the city. SECTION 2: This ordinance shall become effective upon publication.

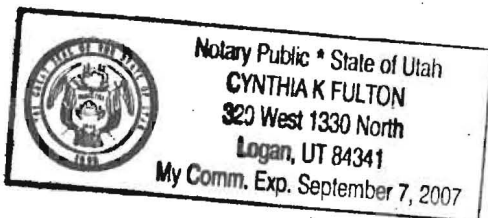

LEGAL NOTICE LOGAN MUNICIPAL COUNCIL

SUMMARIES OF ORDINANCES amending Logan Municipal Code, 1989, passed by the Logan Municipal Council, are as follows:

Ord. 05-56. An ordinance was adopted June 21, 2005 and approved June 22, 2005, amending Section 8.04.010, International Fire Code Adopted. The ordinance adopts the latest published edition of the International Fire Code which is 2003.

Ord. 05-57. An ordinance was adopted June 21, 2005 and approved June 22, 2005 adding Chapter 3.31, Transient Room Tax. The ordinance levies an annual license tax of one percent of the gross revenue derived from the rent for each and every occupancy of a suite, room or rooms, for a period of less than thirty days. The tax is due and payable to the city treasurer quarterly on or before the thirteenth day of the month next succeeding each calendar quarterly period, the first of such quarterly periods being the period commencing with October 1, 2005.
