

**CITY OF LOGAN
RESOLUTION NO. 12-27**

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM YEAR 2012 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN FOR THE CITY OF LOGAN.

WHEREAS, the City of Logan (City) was designated a Metropolitan Statistical Area in May, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to develop an Annual Action Plan each year for submission for approval to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), which plan delineates funding allocations to CDBG subrecipients; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that the City has \$533,443 to allocate to eligible activities based on \$488,989 from HUD for PY2012; \$35,000 recaptured from PY2007; and \$9,454 recaptured from PY2010; and

WHEREAS, the City has complied with the applicable requirements approved by HUD and outlined in the City's Five-Year Consolidated Plan, which requires that:

- a steering committee is formed to meet and review each eligible application for funding and to come to a unanimous consensus for a recommendation; which recommendation includes funding allocations and funding conditions; and which is submitted for approval to the City Council; and
- specified public hearings are held, notices are published, and the Annual Action Plan is made available for public review and comment in accordance with the Citizen Participation Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOGAN, UTAH:

1. The PY2012 Annual Action Plan, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby adopted by the City of Logan and approved to be submitted to HUD.
2. This resolution shall be effective immediately as of the date of its adoption.

PY2012 Annual Action Plan Fund Recommendation**

As determined by unanimous consensus at a meeting that took place 13 March 2012, the CDBG Steering Committee respectfully submits the following funding recommendation:

It is further recommended that:

- 20% of PY2012 funding shall be allocated for program administration and planning and capacity building activities; and
- any funds recaptured from any other CDBG activity for any reason shall be automatically reallocated directly to the "Safe Routes to School" initiative; and
- any variance in the estimated allocation of \$533,443 shall increase or decrease, as the case may be, the allocation to the "Safe Routes to School" initiative. All other allocations shall remain as adopted unless a funding decrease exceeds the full allocation to the "Safe Routes to School" initiative, at which time the City Council shall address reallocation.
