RESOLUTION NO. 12-64

A RESOLUTION SPECIFYING THE PREFERRED INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS FOR THE
200 EAST PROJECT FROM 450 NORTH TO 1250 NORTH

WHEREAS, the 200 East project has recommended the installation of a 2 lane roundabout at 200 East and 1000 North and a single lane roundabout at 200 East and 500 North; and

WHEREAS, the public has expressed concerns regarding pedestrian safety at the 1000 North and 500 North roundabouts; and

WHEREAS, the City of Logan intends to complete the design of the 200 East project prior to the spring of 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LOGAN MUNICIPAL COUNCIL that:

1. The preferred intersection improvements at 1000 North and 200 East is a traffic signal rather than a roundabout.
2. The preferred improvements in front of the Mount Logan Middle School should keep parking on the east side of the street by reducing the width of the median in 200 East.
3. The improvements at 700 North should remain a bulb-out cross walk to reduce pedestrian crossing times.
