



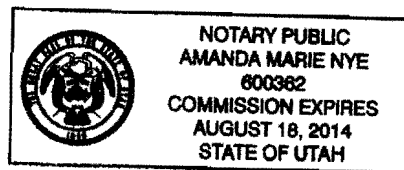

Logan Municipal Council

The Municipal Council of the City of Logan, Utah will hold a public hearing to consider an adjustment to the FY 2012-13 budget appropriating: \$1,696,000 for the bond refinancing resulting in a net present value savings of \$99,916; \$25,000 for the Distracted Driving Grant; (\$54,257) to reduce the County Road Tax Grant; \$23,349 for the purchase of a police vehicle.
