

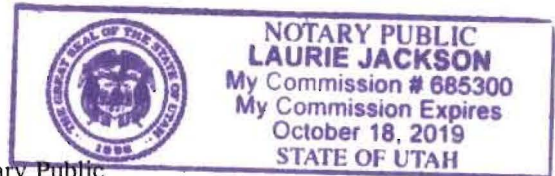

The Municipal Council of the City of Logan, Utah will hold public hearings to consider the following:

Budget Adjustment FY 2016-2017 appropriating: \$75,000 for a grant the parks & recreation Department will receive from the Utah League of Cities and Towns; \$50,000 to amend funds from one of the FY17 RAPZ projects the City was awarded from Cache County for the Park Avenue Connector Trail; \$1,500 for the State Asset Forfeiture Grants the police department was awarded from the State of Utah; \$700 donated funds for the purchase of a flagpole to be constructed at the Don Reese Park baseball complex; \$2,124 restricted funds received from the Peer Court Program toward program expenses for FY2016.
