**A RESOLUTION SELECTING PREFERRED ALTERNATIVE FOR IMPROVING
1000 NORTH 200 WEST TRAFFIC**

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOGAN, UTAH THAT:

WHEREAS, the City of Logan has performed a traffic and corridor study to determine the improvements necessary to improve the level of service of 1000 North for the next 20 years; and

WHEREAS, a public meeting was held to discuss with the surrounding residents and businesses their preferences relating to the proposed alternatives.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Logan Municipal Council, that the proposed preferred alternative for improving 1000 North includes:

- Install a traffic signal at 1000 North and 200 West capable of handling a 5-lane roadway.
- Eliminate parking on 1000 North between Main Street and 200 West and stripe the road to include a continuous center turn lane.
- In the longer term, purchase property to allow the widening of 1000 North to 5 lanes from 200 West through Main Street.
