

**CITY OF LOGAN
RESOLUTION NO. 17-18**

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AMENDMENT #1 TO THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM YEAR 2016 (PY2016) ANNUAL ACTION PLAN (AAP) FOR THE CITY OF LOGAN.

WHEREAS, the City of Logan (City) was designated a Metropolitan Statistical Area in May, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the PY2016 AAP, which delineates the CDBG funding allocations for PY2016, was adopted by the Municipal Council and was approved by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, the CDBG Consolidated Plan for the City of Logan dictates that substantial changes to activities approved within an Annual Action Plan, including (i) changes in the purpose, scope, location or beneficiaries of an activity, or (ii) changes which exceed 50% or \$25,000, whichever is less, of the CDBG funding amount allocated to the subrecipient in the approved Plan necessitate a Council amendment; and

WHEREAS, the Logan Municipal Council desires to comply with the applicable requirements of HUD, notices of this amendment have been published and the amendment has been made available for public comment in accordance with the Citizen Participation Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOGAN, UTAH:

1. That Amendment #1 of the PY2016 AAP, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby adopted by the City of Logan and approved to be submitted to HUD.
2. That this resolution shall be effective immediately as of the date of its adoption.

AMENDMENT #1 PROGRAM YEAR 2016 (PY2016) ANNUAL ACTION PLAN (AAP)

Summary

The purpose of this amendment is to make a changes to the PY2016 AAP. The proposed changes are as follows:

- Cancel the 400 N Medians and Crossings Project
- Cancel the 200 W 1600 N Sidewalk Project (completed without CDBG funds).

The 400 N Medians were originally estimated to cost \$360,000. Due to time constraints during the summer construction season and a general increase in regional construction costs, the revised construction costs for the project are \$650,000. CDBG does not have adequate funds to cover the additional costs. In order to use CDBG funds in a timely manner, it is proposed that the 400 N Median funds be applied to the 300 S Sidewalk.

The 200 W 1600 N Sidewalk Project was completed before the beginning of PY2016 and is therefore ineligible to receive CDBG funding. The project was completed by Logan City Public Works without CDBG funding.

Recommendation

The Logan CDBG Coordinator, Aaron Smith, recommends adoption and approval of this proposed amendment based on the following points:

- The reallocation of the 400 N Medians funds to the 300 S Sidewalk will allow Logan City to expend CDBG funds in a timely manner.
- The 400 N Medians design has been complete and remains an eligible CDBG project to receive CDBG funding or other local funding in the future.
- The 200 W 1600 N Sidewalk has been completed without CDBG funding.
