

**CITY OF LOGAN
RESOLUTION NO. 17-19**

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING AMENDMENT #1 TO THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM YEAR 2015 (PY2015) ANNUAL ACTION PLAN (AAP) FOR THE CITY OF LOGAN.

WHEREAS, the City of Logan (City) was designated a Metropolitan Statistical Area in May, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the PY2015 AAP, which delineates the CDBG funding allocations for PY2015, was adopted by the Municipal Council and was approved by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, the CDBG Consolidated Plan for the City of Logan dictates that substantial changes to activities approved within an Annual Action Plan, including (i) changes in the purpose, scope, location or beneficiaries of an activity, or (ii) changes which exceed 50% or \$25,000, whichever is less, of the CDBG funding amount allocated to the subrecipient in the approved Plan necessitate a Council amendment; and

WHEREAS, the Logan Municipal Council desires to comply with the applicable requirements of HUD, notices of this amendment have been published and the amendment has been made available for public comment in accordance with the Citizen Participation Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOGAN, UTAH:

1. That Amendment #1 of the PY2015 AAP, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby adopted by the City of Logan and approved to be submitted to HUD.
2. That this resolution shall be effective immediately as of the date of its adoption.

AMENDMENT #1 PROGRAM YEAR 2015 (PY2015) ANNUAL ACTION PLAN (AAP)

Summary

The purpose of this amendment is to make a changes to the PY2015 AAP. The proposed changes are as follows:

- Increase the CDBG funding for the 300 S Sidewalk Project to \$494,474.
- Cancel the Boulevard Sidewalk Project (completed without CDBG funds).

The increase in funding for the 300 S Sidewalk Project will cover an increase in construction costs for the project. The project was originally estimated to cost \$350,000, but due to site constraints and a general increase to construction costs in the region, the new construction cost is \$574,474. The Logan City match for this project will remain \$80,000.

The 300 S Sidewalk project will benefit the neighborhood by providing safe pedestrian infrastructure on a corridor that will continue to experience an increase in traffic due to its adjacency to Logan High School, and its proposed future use as a minor arterial road.

Recommendation

The Logan CDBG Coordinator, Aaron Smith, recommends adoption and approval of this proposed amendment based on the following points:

- The safety and connectivity of the 300 S corridor will be significantly improved
- The project meets HUD eligibly requirements
- The Boulevard Sidewalk has been completed without CDBG funding
