RESOLUTION 17-27**

DESIGNATION OF HISTORIC THEATRE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, visionary Cache County settlers invested in cultural infrastructure, counting performance spaces among the first structures they built; and

WHEREAS, municipal, university and private interests have combined to renovate and preserve three historic facilities originally constructed in 1913, 1923 and 1936; and

WHEREAS, these venues have fostered and housed significant countywide artistic activity, economic vitality and community engagement; and

WHEREAS, cultural activities have been identified as a competitive advantage of Cache County, serving residents and attracting cultural tourism and summer citizens.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Logan City Council designates the block bounded by Center Street and 100 South and Main Street and including the West side of 100 West as the Logan City Historic Theatre District and endorses the district's goals of economic vitality and enhancing community life through participation in cultural experiences unique to our community.
