LOGAN CITY INFRASTRUCTURE FUNCTIONING NORMALLY

We understand that residents feel uncertain during this time due to COVID-19 precautions. We want to assure residents that Logan City infrastructure will continue to operate normally.

Water

Logan City's water quality is tested annually and complies with EPA standards for clean and safe drinking water. Drinking water is piped straight from our sources and is never exposed to air or human contact. Our water systems are automatic and can continue functioning without an operator. Residents can expect to continue to have safe and reliable drinking water systems in Logan City. The EPA does not expect COVID-19 to be a threat to municipal water supply.

Electricity

Logan receives electricity from thirteen different power plants both inside the city and outside the county, providing a diversity of sources that reduces our costs and risks. We manage our own electric grid within the city using city employees on three different maintenance crews. This provides low-cost and reliable power year-round that will continue to function normally.

Emergency Services

Utilize city 911 emergency services for emergencies only. If you are feeling sick but not in immediate danger, connect with your doctor, quick care or hospital online or on the phone before seeking in-person treatment (see below).

Hospital Services

If you have any cold/flu symptoms or have questions, use telehealth services (phone apps, websites, phone #s) provided by local hospitals and insurance providers before going to a facility to avoid overloading hospitals, clinics, and ERs. You will then receive instruction about whether or not to go to a healthcare facility for follow-up.

Roads

We are nearing the end of the winter season, but snow removal will function normally. Winter parking regulations end March 15th.

Garbage & Recycling

These will continue to be collected on the normal schedules.
