Resolution No. 14-05 RDA A RESOLUTION APPROVING AGENCY ASSISTANCE FOR A ROAD MEDIAN LANDSCAPING PROJECT IN THE SOUTH MAIN REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA (RDA)

WHEREAS, the City of Logan has adopted policies for assistance in projects and improvements in Redevelopment and Economic Development Project Areas; and

WHEREAS, the Road Median Landscaping Project ("Project") improves the entrance into Logan by enhancing the aesthetic quality of Main Street at the location commonly referred to as the "Y" at the juncture of Highway 89/91 and S.R. 165; and

WHEREAS, the "Project" beautifies the median by replacing the existing asphalt with low-maintenance plant material that conforms to UDOT safety standards and will be maintained by Logan City Parks & Recreation Department subsequent to an initial maintenance period of two to three years during which time the maintenance will be performed by a landscape contractor; and

WHEREAS, the Economic Development Committee has reviewed the proposed investment and recommends its approval;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Logan does hereby resolve to appropriate an estimated \$32,600 for the "Project" as follows:

- \$25,000 for project construction to include site preparation, topsoil, installation of irrigation, plant and other landscape materials;
- \$3,600, or \$1,200/year for maintenance services to be provided by a landscape contractor for up to a three year period;
- \$3000 \$4,000 for the preparation of construction drawings related to the project.

Additionally, the Redevelopment Agency encourages the City of Logan to utilize local contractors and vendors whenever possible.

- \$25,000 for project construction to include site preparation, topsoil, installation of irrigation, plant and other landscape materials:
- \$3,600, or \$1,200/year for maintenance services to be provided by a landscape contractor for up to a three
 year period;
- \$3000 \$4,000 for the preparation of construction drawings related to the project.
- \$2,500 for the installation of the fish sculpture;

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


Concept C2

Low Maintenance Naturalistic Plantings

NOTES:

- 1. All plant material taller than 18" shatt be planted outside of site distance lines.
- 2. UDOT approved barrier fabric shall be used to separate top soil from adjacent road base material.
- 3. Existing asphalt to be removed and a minimum of 18" of topsoil shall be placed in planting area.
- Drip irrigation shall be used to increase watering efficiency and reduce over-spray onto adjacent roadway.
- A flow sensor shall be used on the irrigation system to automatically shut down the system in the event of a break.
- Landscape maintenance to be performed by Logan City Parks and Rec. Department in accordance with UDOT standards and specifications.







Concept C3 Low Maintenance


Low Maintenance Naturalistic Plantings / Dry Riverbed

NOTES.

- 1. All plant material taller than 18" shall be planted outside of site distance lines.
- UDOT approved barrier fabric shall be used to separate top soil from adjacent road base material.
 Existing asphalt to be removed and a minimum
- of 18" of topsoil shall be placed in planting area.

 4. Drip irrigation shall be used to increase watering efficiency and reduce over-spray onto adjacent roadway.
- A flow sensor shall be used on the imgation system to automatically shut down the system in the event of a break.
- Landscape maintenance to be performed in accordance with UDOT standards and specifications.
- 7. Cobble and gravel mulch areas to be typically 3" minus. In dry riverbed areas larger diameter stones may be used if they are buried and no more than 6" is visible above grade.

"Y" Intersection



Lower Maintenance Dense Green Plantings Low Flat Stone Accents

NOTES

- 1 All plant material taller than 18" shall be planted outside of site distance lines
- 2 UDOT approved barrier fabric shall be used to separate top soil from adjacent road base material. 3. Existing asphalt to be removed and a minimum of 18" of topsoil shall be placed in planting area
- 4. Drip irrigation shall be used to increase watering efficiency and reduce over-spray onto adjacent roadway
- 5 A flow sensor shall be used on the irrigation system to automatically shut down the system in the event of a break
- 6. Landscape maintenance to be performed in accordance with UDOT standards and specifications.
- 7 Gravel mulch areas to be typically 2" minus to areas of stone pockets use large flat (flagstone) to give appearance of large buried boulders (no more than 6-12" is visible above grade)





- 5. A flow sensor shall be used on the irrigation system to automatically shut down the system in the event of a break.
- 6. Landscape maintenance to be performed in accordance with UDOT standards and specifications
- 7 Gravel mulch areas to be typically 2" minus In areas of stone pockets use large flat (flagstone) to give appearance of large huned boulders (no more than 6-12" is visible above grade)




