

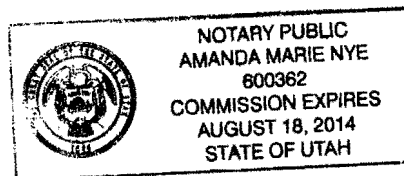

**Logan Municipal Council**

The Municipal Council of the City of Logan, Utah will hold public hearings to consider the following:

An adjustment to the FY 2013-2014 budget appropriating: \$104 donated funds for the K9 Program; \$1,444,176 from General Fund Reserves for the removal of the Logan Golf Course interfund loan; \$337,000 for wetland mitigation and storm water treatment for the 800 North project; \$85,000 for additional canal maintenance and canal water shares.

Consideration of a proposed ordinance amending Section 10.52.270 of the Logan Municipal Code regarding Excessive Noise and Pollution.
