

**CITY OF LOGAN
RESOLUTION NO. 13-28**

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM YEAR 2013 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN FOR THE CITY OF LOGAN.

WHEREAS, the City of Logan (City) was designated a Metropolitan Statistical Area in May, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to develop an Annual Action Plan each year for submission for approval to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), which plan delineates funding allocations to CDBG subrecipients; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that the City has \$464,500 to allocate from HUD for PY2013; and

WHEREAS, the City has complied with the applicable requirements approved by HUD and outlined in the City's Five-Year Consolidated Plan, which requires that:

- a steering committee, comprised of each City Council member or a designated resident representative acting on a nonparticipating Council member's behalf, is formed to meet and review each eligible application for funding and to come to a unanimous consensus for a recommendation; which recommendation includes funding allocations and funding conditions; and which is submitted for approval to the collective City Council; and
- specified public hearings are held, notices are published, and the Annual Action Plan is made available for public review and comment in accordance with the Citizen Participation Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LOGAN, UTAH:

1. The PY2013 Annual Action Plan funding decision, attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference, is hereby adopted by the City of Logan and approved to be submitted to HUD.
2. This resolution shall be effective immediately as of the date of its adoption.



Exhibit A
PY2013 Annual Action Plan Fund Recommendation

As determined by unanimous consensus at a meeting that took place 26 March 2013, the CDBG Steering Committee respectfully submits the following funding recommendation:

\$20,000 - New Boiler - Whittier Community Center Inc.
\$10,000 - Website and Program Development - Cache Valley Volunteer Center
\$8,000 - Communications Network System Update - Child & Family Support Center
\$15,000 - CETC Improvement Project - Cache Employment & Training Center
\$49,000 - Neighborhood/Block Improvement Program - Logan Community Development
\$290,040 - Neighborhood infrastructure in low/moderate income service areas - Logan Public Works

It is further recommended that:

- 16% of PY2012 funding shall be allocated for program administration; and
- any funds recaptured from any other CDBG activity for any reason shall be automatically reallocated directly to the neighborhood infrastructure in low/moderate income service areas activity; and
- any variance in the estimated allocation of \$464,500 shall increase or decrease, as the case may be, the allocation to the neighborhood infrastructure in low/moderate income service areas activity. All other allocations shall remain as adopted unless a funding decrease exceeds the full allocation to the neighborhood infrastructure in low/moderate income service areas activity, at which time the City Council shall address reallocation.



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG)

Notice is hereby given that Logan Municipal Council (LMC) will hold two public hearings related to CDBG funding priorities and allocations for CDBG program year 2013 (PY2013). PY2013 CDBG funding estimate is \$489,989. Both public hearings shall commence no earlier than 5:30pm in the LMC Chambers located at 290 N 100 W, Logan, Utah.

PUBLIC HEARING #1 is scheduled for 5 February 2013 for the purpose of receiving public input from Logan residents and agencies regarding 2013 CDBG funding priorities and performance measures.

PUBLIC HEARING #2 is scheduled for 7 May 2013 for the purpose of receiving public input by Logan residents and agencies regarding the proposed 2013 Annual Action Plan (Plan). The Plan includes the funding recommendation of the CDBG Steering Committee to be upheld or amended by the LMC.

TO APPLY FOR FUNDING CONSIDERATION, go to www.loganutah.org (CDBG section) or Logan City Hall for the pre-application and application forms. The application period runs from 7 February 2013 (8:00am) until 7 March 2013 (4:30pm). Application technical assistance is readily available, primarily by appointment (by calling 435-716-9008).

THE PUBLIC REVIEW AND COMMENT PERIOD for the Plan runs 7 April 2012 to 7 May 2012, at the conclusion of the public hearing. An executive summary of the Plan is available as of 7 April 2013; electronically at www.loganutah.org (CDBG section) and in hard copy at Logan City Hall reception desk, 290 N 100 W, Logan, Utah. Written public comments provided during the comment period will be summarized in the Plan. Only those verbal comments expressed during either public hearing to the LMC will be included in the Plan.
