

The Municipal Council of the City of Logan, Utah will hold a public hearing to consider the following:

An adjustment to the FY 2013-14 budget appropriating: \$72,392 for the 2013 RAPZ Tax Municipal Population Allocation for the 2013 Freedom Fire event and 1800 S 100 W trail project; \$40,000 for the 2013 RAPZ Tax Municipal Population Allocation for Phase Two Dog Park/Emergency Site; \$130,073 for the 21st Century Grant to support After School Programs in the Logan City School District; \$12,000 for funds awarded to the Logan City Police Department from the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force of Utah; \$4,442 for the State Asset Forfeiture Grant awarded for FY2014; \$8,649 reimbursement to the Logan City Fire Department for the Wildflower Wildfland Fire deployment.

An adjustment to the FY 2013-2014 budget appropriating: \$300,000 for the purchase of property to be used for a trail head and park property (20 acres located at approximately 1500 \$ 1600 W in unincorporated Cache County. (\$134,700 to be used for existing Parks & Recreation Capital appropriation and an additional \$300,000 to be seller financed over 3 years at 3% interest.
